The Holy Name of Jesus

The month of January is dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus, which is celebrated on January 3. The first ten days of January fall during the liturgical season known as Christmas which is represented by the liturgical color white the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored). The remaining days of January are the beginning of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green.



Thou shalt call His Name Jesus, for He shall save His people from their sins.

This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time.

El Santo Nombre de Jesús

El mes de enero está dedicado al Santo Nombre de Jesús, el cual se celebra el 3 de enero. Los primeros diez días de enero caen durante el tiempo litúrgico conocido como Navidad que se representa con el color litúrgico blanco el color de la luz, símbolo de alegría, pureza e inocencia (absoluta o restaurada). Los días restantes de enero son el comienzo del Tiempo Ordinario, que está representado por el color litúrgico verde. Este símbolo de esperanza tiene el color de la semilla que brota y suscita en los fieles la esperanza de recoger la mies eterna del cielo, especialmente la esperanza de una resurrección gloriosa. Se utiliza en los oficios y Misas del Tiempo Ordinario.

Liturgical ministers serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors (Ministers of the Word at Mass.

To serve as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, persons must:

- be practicing Catholics, distinguished in their Christian life, faith and morals;
- be at least 16 years old;
- have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist;
- demonstrate a deep reverence for and devotion to the holy Eucharist;
- possess the requisite abilities and temperament to carry out their assigned duties.
- should periodically participate in enrichment programs.

To Serve as a Minister of the Word (Lector), persons must:

Meet the guidelines above and must be properly trained for their ministry. This ministry of the Word requires skill in public reading, knowledge of the principles of liturgy, and an understanding of the scriptures.

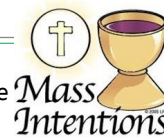
