



DID YOU KNOW? It is not too late to become a Liturgical Minister at mass! Liturgical ministers serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors (Ministers of the Word) at Mass.

A second Commissioning (and Recommissioning) will be scheduled in the near future. Training Sessions are required.

To serve as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, persons must:

- a. be practicing Catholics, distinguished in their Christian life, faith and morals;
- b. be at least 16 years old;
- c. have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist;
- d. demonstrate a deep reverence for and devotion to the
- e. possess the requisite abilities and temperament to carry out their assigned duties.
- f. should periodically participate in enrichment programs.

To serve as a Minister of the Word (Lector), persons

Meet the requirements above and be properly trained for the ministry. This ministry of the Word requires skill in public reading, knowledge of the principles of liturgy, and an understanding of the scriptures.



Today Jesus said in the Gospel, "Rejoice and be glad,

for your reward will be great in heaven." (Matthew 5:12)

He commanded us to rejoice in our persecution. Jesus doesn't ask us to rejoice in pain for pain's sake. As he faced his agony, Jesus himself asked that the cup of suffering "might pass from me." Jesus shares our very human and very good desire to avoid pain when it makes sense to do so. He commanded us to rejoice when in pain for his sake."If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you," he candidly reminded those following him (John 15:20). Pain comes to those who follow him. That's the bad news. The good news is it will eventually be okay—more than OK. We will possess him in perfect beatitude one day. It's worth anything this valley of tears can throw at us because the valley has an end. Today, Jesus entrusts our parish with the mission to help local Christians make it there.
