





Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time Without Cost

Part of being a believer is knowing that God keeps his promises. And how do we know that? Because he has kept them in the past. If we lose hope or begin to doubt whether he will help us, we remember what he has already done. That's what Paul is talking about in the second reading. Christ died for us when we were sinners, so Paul concludes that now that we have been saved from sin, we will also be saved from death. So now we are free from sin and death. Isn't that enough?

Jesus shows that there is still more that God can do. When he saw the crowds in today's gospel, he pitied them because they were "like sheep without a shepherd." They seemed to need leaders, someone who could show them the way to God. So Jesus responds in two ways. First, he teaches his disciples to pray for more leaders. What he means is that if people are to lead the Church, they must be sent by God. They are not elected by popular vote. They are "elected" or called by God to serve. Jesus is teaching us to pray for Church leaders today. We can pray for all who have leadership roles, that they are filled with wisdom and strength. Jesus also teaches us to pray for vocations to religious life.

The second thing Jesus does is to send the twelve apostles out to proclaim the kingdom and cure diseases. He shows us that along with prayer, we need to take action. This may mean offering our help to parish leaders, serving a term on the parish council, or encouraging our children to consider a religious vocation.

Why should we do these things? Remember what Paul said about God saving us from sin and death. God gives these gifts without cost. He simply asks us to pass on that good news of salvation. That is what leadership in the Church is all about.

As Catholics, we are called to have Christ within us, being filled with the Holy Spirit and being "not people of the book, but people of the living word." We are not to live in passive reflection but active service amongst one

Who can you lead to Christ through sharing the Gospel? Make a goal of picking a person or group every year to speak to. Someday, when face to face with God after this life, He will ask us, who did you bring with you to heaven?

Today, let us pray: "Lord, help us to go and make disciples. May others see Christ in each of us." Amen!


