






The Holy Name of Jesus

The month of January is dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus, which is celebrated on January 3. The first ten days of January fall during the liturgical season known as Christmas which is represented by the liturgical color white the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored).

The remaining days of January are the beginning of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time.

El Santo Nombre de Jesús

El mes de enero está dedicado al Santo Nombre de Jesús, el cual se celebra el 3 de enero. Los primeros diez días de enero caen durante el tiempo litúrgico conocido como Navidad que se representa con el color litúrgico blanco el color de la luz, símbolo de alegría, pureza e inocencia (absoluta o restaurada).

Los días restantes de enero son el comienzo del Tiempo Ordinario, que está representado por el color litúrgico verde. Este símbolo de esperanza tiene el color de la semilla que brota y suscita en los fieles la esperanza de recoger la mies eterna del cielo, especialmente la esperanza de una resurrección gloriosa. Se utiliza en los oficios y Misas del Tiempo Ordinario.

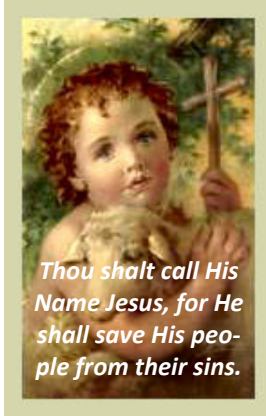

Commonly Asked Questions on the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God

What is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God?

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, falls on New Year's Day; it celebrates Mary as the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of the Church.

Though there are many other solemnities in the Church (read the next question), this holy day is often shortened to "the Solemnity," even though there are five other solemnities in the Church. As Pope Francis said in his 2022 homily on this day, "The New Year begins under the sign of the Holy Mother of God, under the sign of the Mother. A mother's gaze is the path to rebirth and growth."

How is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, celebrated?

A holy day of obligation, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is most commonly celebrated with Mass. On this day, we celebrate Mary as the Mother of Jesus.

When is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God?

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is celebrated on January 1 (New Year's Day) every year. This year, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, falls on a Sunday.

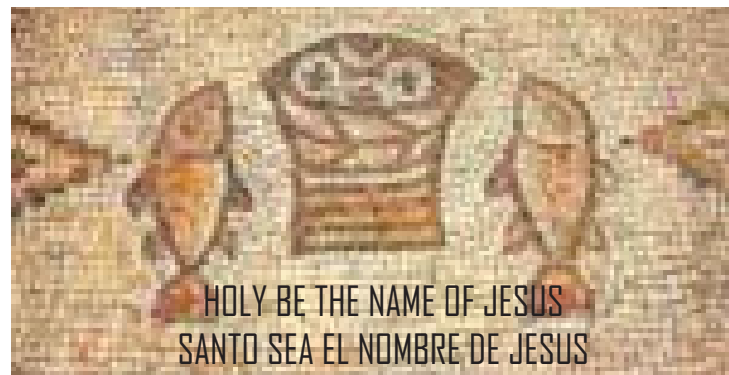
Is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, a holy day of obligation?

Yes, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, is a holy day of obligation. The Church encourages all Catholics, who are able, to attend Mass on the Solemnity. The USCCB allows two exceptions, however: when the Solemnity falls on a Saturday or Monday, "the precept to attend Mass is abrogated."

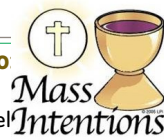
Is a solemnity the same as a feast?

Yes, and no. Solemnities are special feasts – those greatly important to the Church and theology. All Sundays and holy days of obligation are solemnities, though not all solemnities are holy days of obligation.

Other holy days of obligation include the Nativity of Jesus (December 25), the Immaculate Conception of Mary (December 8), the Solemnity of the Ascension of Christ (Thursday of the sixth week of Easter), the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary (August 15), and All Saints' Day (November 1).
