

From the Book of Blessings before and after meals:

BEFORE THE PRINCIPAL MEAL

1033 The person who is presiding at table says: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All make the sign of the cross and reply: Amen.

Then: The eyes of all creatures look to you to give them food in due time. R. You give it to them, they gather it up; you open your hand, they have their fill.

Let us call on the name of the Father, who always takes care of his children. **R.** Our Father . . . but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and for ever. Amen.

The one presiding then signs himself or herself with the sign of the cross (a priest or a deacon also makes the sign of the cross over the food) and says: Bless + us, O Lord, and these your gifts which we are about to receive from your goodness. Through Christ our Lord. R. Amen.

AFTER THE PRINCIPAL MEAL

1034 Let all your works praise you, 0 Lord. R. Let all your people bless you.

We give you thanks for all your gifts, almighty God, living and reigning now and for ever. R. Amen.

For the sake of your name, O Lord, reward those who have, been good to us and give them eternal life. **R**. Amen.


